House Rules

- Players must be respectful to all other players and Pro Football Academy/Arena staff, in every manner.
- You must remain with your specific group for all sessions.
- The camp does not tolerate bullying and if there are any issues, you must let a staff member know so that this can be addressed.
- There is a strict 3-strike policy regarding behaviour at the camp.
- Phones are allowed however, if they are misused, they will be confiscated and returned at the end of the day.
- Shin pads and suitable footwear must be worn.

If there are minor issues on the camp, these will be addressed by Pro Football Arena/Academy staff during the day. However, if issues continue throughout the day, Pro Football Arena/Academy staff will need to discuss these with parents.

If issues persist or the code of conduct is broken, we will take the following action:

First Incident

Parents will be contacted so that the issue can be addressed and discussed with the parent.

Second Incident

Parents will be contacted again and depending on the severity of the issue, the player may have to be picked up from the camp or given a warning.

Third Incident

The child will need to be picked up from the camp and a decision will be made as to whether they can attend for the rest of the week if they are booked on.

When a booking is made, both the parent and the child agree to the code of conduct above.
